FRIDAY 12:45 p.m. Classes

Onion Ring Flower Brooch **FULL** 2.0 hrs **Class Type:** Technique
Georgia Seitz **Level:** Intermediate & up **Class Limit:** 15

~~This free form pattern combines onion rings, chains, spiral chains and encapsulation to create a decoration suitable for a brooch. Basic tatting skills required.~~

~~**Materials:** 2 shuttles and 2 colors of thread in flower and leaf colors~~

~~**Kit:** optional, \$2.00~~

Beaded Star for a Tatting Journal 2.0 hrs **Class Type:** Project
Karey Solomon **Level:** Intermediate & up **Class Limit:** 12

Tat a beaded star to decorate a tatting journal with interfacing pages. Basic tatting skills are required. You will learn mock rings and using beads.

Materials: 140 seed beads pre-strung as follows for your choice of thread: size 10 beads on size 10 thread, or size 11 beads on 20 thread, or size 13-15 beads on 40 thread; 2 shuttles wound CTM with beads split 100 on SH1 and 40 on SH2 for post shuttles and equally for bobbin shuttles.

Kit: optional, \$4.00 for pre-strung thread and \$5.00 for the journal.

Tatting with Yarn 2.0 hrs **Class Type:** Technique
Jessica Spaulding **Level:** Adv. Beginner & up **Class Limit:** 12

Yes, you CAN tat with yarn! In this class we will start with a small medallion that can serve as a necklace pendant. If desired, students can add a second round that will turn this medallion into the focal point of a decorative belt.

Materials: 1 large post style shuttle (SewMate, Starlit, Tatsy etc.) and a skein of BRAIDED knitting cotton.

Tatting with yarn is best done with a large post shuttle and nothing smaller than a SewMate is recommended.

Kit: optional, \$5.00 - 10.00 for yarn.

Spanish Dancer Earrings 2.0 hrs **Class Type:** Project
Krystle Pyette **Level:** Intermediate **Repeats Saturday at 9:30** **Class Limit:** 12

Students will be tatting Krystle's earring pattern. Basic tatting skills are required plus knowledge of split rings and sewing in ends. Class will cover tatting over a cabone ring, basic use of beads and tips for finishing.

Materials: for each earring: size 20 thread, 2 shuttles wound CTM with 30 seed beads and 6 yards of thread split equally on shuttles (18 beads on SH1, 12 on SH2), 2 earring hooks, and 2 half inch cabone rings.

Kit: optional, \$2.50 for earring findings and cabone rings.

Mock Hairpin Doily 2.0 hrs **Class Type:** Technique
Sherry Pence **Level:** Intermediate **Repeats Saturday at 9:30** **Class Limit:** 12

Students will learn Ruth Perry's tatted mock hairpin lace (TMHPL) technique of flipped and un-flipped stitches to create a small doily. Basic tatting skills are required plus mock picot and split ring.

Materials: 2 shuttles wound CTM with size 20 thread, 2 large picot gauges - 1½ inch and 2 1/8 inch wide (old credit cards work great) and a safety pin.

Snowflake 2008 2.0 hrs **Class Type:** Project
Dale Pomeroy **Level:** Advanced **Class Limit:** 15

This is an expert open-centered snowflake pattern consisting of rings, chains, picots, joins-picot, shuttle/lock, smooth sided, over/under, beaded picot; beading foundation and auxiliary threads, front side/back side tatting, reverse stitch rings/chains, rings thrown off chains, multiple shuttles (3). Extended picots are optional.

Materials: 3 shuttles, size 20 Cordonnet, 12 small bugle beads (Mill Hill #72010), 24 petite beads (Mill Hill #42010), 6 seed beads (MH #02010), size 16 crochet hook and a ¼" or 6mm picot gauge.

Coloring Metal Findings**2.0 hrs****Class Type:** Project

Level: All**Class Limit:** 12

I have a black bead cap but I want it to be green. How do I do that? This class is all about using different mediums to color metal or plastic findings and beads. We will use alcohol inks, acrylic paint, nail polish, ink pads, colored pencil and Krylon sealer. THIS CLASS WILL BE SMELLY and we may end up working outside, or at least with the door open so dress accordingly.

Materials: none. The coloring agents will be provided, as will the metal and plastic parts that we will color.

Kit: required, \$1.00 for the findings and use of the coloring agents.

FRIDAY 3:00 p.m. Classes**Onion Ring Pincushion****FULL****1.5 hrs****Class Type:** Technique

The onion ring is a very traditional technique that has been in use since the late 1800's. Class will learn to tat a ring within a ring and the ball thread join that holds the onion ring together while making a motif to decorate the top of a pincushion or a fabric postcard.

Materials: 2 shuttles and a ball or 3 shuttles, 3 colors of thread.

Kit: optional, \$2.00 for a fabric postcard or pincushion ready to decorate.

Easy Beady Earrings**1.5 hrs****Class Type:** Project

Level: Adv. Beginner & up**Class Limit:** 12

Simple can be stunning - using a lot of beads and one beaded ring, you will create an easy pair of earrings.

Materials: 1 shuttle

Kit: required, \$3.00 for strong metallic thread, beads, shepherd's hook earrings and bead threader.

1925 Medallion**1.5 hrs****Class Type:** Project

Level: Adv. Beginner & up**Class Limit:** 18

We will tat a circular motif from the 1925 Priscilla Tatting Book #3. This will give you a chance to practice translating antique patterns to modern day short hand. The motif can be used as a very nice necklace pendant or you can make all 30 for the Star Doily shown in the book.

Materials: 1 shuttle or needle and thread of your choice.

Simple Swirl Rhinestone Bracelet**FULL****1.5 hrs****Class Type:** Project

Level: Adv. Beginner & up**Class Limit:** 12

In this class you will make a surprisingly easy to complete bracelet by attaching tatting to a pre-made rhinestone bracelet. This makes a great gift, and is quick and easy to finish.

Materials: 1 shuttle and size 10 or 20 thread of your choice. (This pattern works especially well with variegated or hand dyed threads.)

Kit: required \$4.00 for bracelet (Plus size bracelet kit available, contact Krystle prior to workshop for details.)

Split Rings**1.5 hrs****Class Type:** Technique

Level: Adv. Beginner & up**Class Limit:** 12

This class is an introduction to split rings and their use in knotless tatting and for ornamental use. Students will tat an icicle. Basic tatting skills are required.

Materials: 2 shuttles pre-wound, 2 colors of size 10 thread, and your basic tatting kit.

What Do I Do NOW!!!**1.5 hrs****Class Type:** Help

Level: Beginner - Intermediate**Class Limit:** 4

Have you tried a pattern and gotten stuck? Do you have an old project, one you are unable to finish? Are you having trouble getting started? Bring the pattern and the tatted piece worked to that "iffy" part and let's figure it out together. Basic tatting skills are required.

Materials: basic tatting tools and the project that is giving you trouble.

Paperclip Pals **1.5 hrs** **Class Type:** Technique
 Wendy Griffin **Level:** Adv. Beginner **Repeats Saturday at 3:00** **Class Limit:** 12
 Learn how to attach your tatting to a paperclip. This class is for both needle and shuttle tatters. We will be making a snail and butterfly. Basic tatting skills of rings and joins are required.
Materials: 1 shuttle and 10 yards of size 20 or 30 thread, or a size 5 or 7 needle and 6 yards of size 20 or 30 thread. Paperclips will be provided or you can bring your own.

SATURDAY 9:45 a.m. Classes

Pearl/Maltese Tatted Chain Basics **2.0 hrs** **Class Type:** Technique
 Georgia Seitz **Level:** Adv. Beginner & up **Class Limit:** 15
 The pearl tatted chain, also called Maltese tatting, requires three threads and can create some very decorative chains by varying the stitch count and picots. Class will learn to tat the chains and use them to decorate a fabric postcard or pincushion.
Materials: 2 shuttles and a ball, or 3 shuttles, and 3 colors of thread.
Kit: optional, \$2.00 for fabric postcard or pincushion ready to decorate.

Bunch of Grapes **2.0 hrs** **Class Type:** Technique
 Karey Solomon **Level:** Intermediate & up **Class Limit:** 12
 Learn to make Catherine wheels in a series, as seen in Karey's book *Wandering Wheels*, without the need to cut, tie and start again. Basic tatting skills are required.
Materials: 2 shuttles wound CTM in the thread of your choice for the grapes and green thread for the leaves.

~~Chain of Hearts **Full** **2.0 hrs** **Class Type:** Technique
 Jessica Spaulding **Level:** Intermediate & up **Class Limit:** 12
 Learn the single shuttle split ring (SSSR) to make Gina Butler's 'Heart Strings' pattern for a string of cute-dimpled hearts. They are a great way to use the thread left on your shuttle and you can cut them apart without them unraveling.
Materials: 1 shuttle wound with thread of your choice.~~

Mock Hairpin Doily **2.0 hrs** **Class Type:** Technique

Split Chains / Bridging / Knot Stitch **2.0 hrs** **Class Type:** Technique
 Mary McCarthy **Level:** Intermediate & up **Class Limit:** 12
 This class explains the bridging technique used to jump rounds in knotless tatting. Students will tat the knot stitch rose motif from the *Priscilla Tatting Book No 3*.
Materials: 2 shuttles wound, 2 contrasting colors of size 10 thread

Beginning Needle Tatting **2.0 hrs** **Class Type:** Technique
 Wendy Griffin **Level:** Beginner **Class Limit:** 12
 This class is for everyone who would like to learn needle tatting. We will learn the basics - rings, chains, picots, joins, reverse work, adding a new thread, hiding threads and reading patterns. You should be able to complete a small motif by the end of class.
Materials: size 5 tatting needle, size 10 thread
Kit: optional, \$6.00 for needle and thread

Tatting 101 - Beginning Shuttle **5.0 hrs** **Class Type:** Technique
 Lois Bresnahan **Level:** Beginner **Continues at 1:00 & 3:00** **Class Limit:** 12
 No experience necessary. Students will learn tatting basics - double stitch, rings, chains and joins - using a simple motif pattern. Reading both written and visual patterns will be discussed, as well as some of the useful tools used by tatters.
Materials: a sense of humor, patience and a basic tatting kit consisting of 2 shuttles, one ball each of size 10 crochet thread in white and a bright contrasting color, a pair of scissors or other cutting device, and a crochet hook (suitable for the thread size).

Heart with Onion & Split Rings

1.5 hrs

Class Type: Technique

Georgia Seitz

Level: Intermediate & up

Class Limit: 15

Tat a pretty heart with onion and split rings. Students will learn the ball thread join needed to create the onion ring, a set of 2 (or more rings) which surround each other. The finished heart will be used on a simple pop-up greeting card. Basic tatting skills and split rings are required.

Materials: 2 shuttles, thread

Kit: optional, \$2.00 for two greeting cards and the materials needed for the pop-up mechanism.

Cactus Flower Bookmark FULL

1.5 hrs

Class Type: Project

Karey Solomon

Level: Adv. Beginner & up

Class Limit: 12

This one shuttle bookmark based on a vintage insertion takes a little concentration, but the pattern repeats and the result is pretty and a lot of fun to tat. The bookmark may be made as long as you want it to be. Basic tatting skills are required. Class will cover pattern reading, different joins, gauging bare thread spacing, how to join a final ring without twisting the picot and ways of ending bookmarks. For the intermediate students, this is a good project for practicing front side/back side tatting.

Materials: 1 full shuttle (post style) or 2 full bobbins (bobbin shuttle), crochet hook for joins, and needle for sewing in the ends.

Quick, Single-Pass Choker

1.5 hrs

Class Type: Project

Level: Adv. Beginner & up

Class Limit: 15

Use split rings and a lock chain to make a quick flower necklace. If time allows, we will also go over some quick, lock stitch lariat necklaces.

Materials: 2 shuttles wound CTM with thread of your choice.

Petal Perfect Necklace FULL

3.0 hrs

Class Type: Project

Krystle Pyette

Level: Intermediate

Class Limit: 12

Class will create Krystle's "Petal Perfect" necklace design while learning how to use her method of making an invisible lark head picot join. Students will get a quick review of covering a cabone ring with stitches to get started and also basic beads. Basic tatting skills, use of two shuttles and sewing in ends are required.

Materials: 2 empty shuttles, 4 solid colors of size 20 thread - green for leaves, yellow or orange for flower center, and two complimentary colors for the petal layers; 16 size 11 seed beads and a size 16 crochet hook or a split dental floss threader for placing seed beads over picot.

Kit: required, \$5.00 for all jewelry components and cabone ring only. (Students are responsible for thread and beads.)

Snowflake 2011

1.5 hrs

Class Type: Project

Dale Pomeroy

Level: Advanced

Class Limit: 15

This is an expert ring-centered snowflake pattern consisting of rings, chains, picots, joins, shuttle/lock joins, beaded picots, beaded picot joins, extended picots, exchanging shuttles, reverse stitches, split ring, split chains, tatting over tails and padded tatting. Additional beads and extended picots are optional.

Materials: 2 shuttles, size 20 Cordonnet thread, size 16 crochet hook, picot gauges ¼ inch and 5/8 inch, 12 each ¼ in bugle beads, 12 each size 11 seed beads.

Pumpkin Earrings

1.5 hrs

Class Type: Project

Lauren Snyder

Level: Adv. Beginner & up

Class Limit: 12

This is a simple and cute pattern consisting of four rings, a bead and earring findings. Students will learn a simple way to color a metal finding and use wire to make a loop for hanging the pumpkin. Ability to tat rings with a shuttle or needle is required. You will have the option to change the color of thread and beads to have apples instead.

Materials: 1 empty shuttle or tatting needle.

Kit: required, \$1.00 for thread, beads and all findings for 1 pair of earrings.

Intermediate Needle Tatting

1.5 hrs

Class Type: Technique

Level: Adv. Beginner - Intermediate

Class Limit: 12

Now that you can make rings and chains, see what else you can create with a needle. Class will learn split rings, split chains, adding beads, two color tatting and adding a new thread while making a Christmas tree ornament. Basic needle tatting skills required. (Continued on next page.)

Materials: size 5 tatting needle, size 10 thread and approximately 100 seed beads (large enough to go over the needle) with 40 on the ball and 60 loose.

Kit: optional, \$2.00 for beads and thread.

SATURDAY 3:00 p.m. Classes

Fancy Beaded Pearl Tatting Sachet 1.5 hrs **Class Type:** Project
Georgia Seitz **Level:** Adv. Beginner & up **Class Limit:** 15

Use three threads, beads and pearl tatted chains to create a large beaded design.

Materials: 2 shuttles and a ball or 3 shuttles, 3 colors of thread, beads.

Kit: optional, \$2.00.

Edging for the well-dressed Tatter 1.5 hrs **Class Type:** Project
Karey Solomon **Level:** Adv. Beginner – Intermediate **Class Limit:** 12

This is a new, original pattern designed for a t-shirt but can also be used to decorate linens. It is easy to do but will also hold your attention. Class will cover block tatting, onion rings, switching threads and attaching tatting to fabric. Basic tatting skills are required.

Materials: 1 shuttle wound CTM to ball, size 20 thread (recommended) or finer of your choice; needle and thread to match fabric; thimble (if you use one).

Photographing Tatting 1.5 hrs **Class Type:** Technique
Jessica Spaulding **Level:** All **Class Limit:** 12

Bring your camera and we will go over macro settings. We will see how to build an easy and cheap light box and go over tips for making your tatting pop on the page or computer screen.

Materials: digital camera

Angel / Flower Fairy Ornament 1.5 hrs **Class Type:** Project
Lauren Snyder **Level:** Adv. Beginner & up **Class Limit:** 12

This little angel or fairy is worked in an unusual order and ends with a split ring. This could be the perfect introduction to split rings if you are a beginner. The ornament will be completed in class. Ability to tat rings is required.

Materials: 1 shuttle wound with 3 yards of size 10 thread and 1 empty shuttle.

Kit: required, \$1.00 for the crystal for the body of the ornament.

Snowflake 2010 1.5 hrs **Class Type:** Project
Dale Pomeroy **Level:** Intermediate **Class Limit:** 15

This is an intermediate open-centered snowflake pattern consisting of clovers, over and under joins, chains, rings and rings thrown off of chains. The blending filament will be added to all chains.

Materials: 2 tatting shuttles, size 14 crochet hook, size 22/24 tapestry needle, size 50 white Cordonnet thread, Kreinik Blending Filament color #032 (the spool will be used as the shuttle), 2 5/8 inch metal or plastic ring

Note: metal rings will be available at the workshop.

Paperclip Pals 1.5 hrs **Class Type:** Technique
