

## 2017 Shuttlebirds Vending

The sales room will be open as follows:

Thursday, May 4th,	4:00 pm - 8:00 pm
Friday, May 5th,	8:30 am - noon, 1:00 pm - 5:30 pm, 6:30 pm - 8:00 pm
Saturday, May 6th	8:30 am - noon, 1:00 pm - 5:30 pm

All vendors are required to collect and remit the 6% Idaho sales tax, no exceptions. There are two ways you can do this:

You must be set up with the state to collect the tax and remit it yourself, or you must provide Ross Point with a total of your sales and the sales tax and they will remit it to the state on their monthly reporting.

The tables are 8' long.

Table fee is \$30 per table.

Lodging and meal packages are available and are charged per person:

Double/triple occupancy (twin beds)	3 nights/7 meals	\$215
	2 nights/5 meals	\$155
Single occupancy (limited availability)	3 nights/7 meals	\$280
	2 nights/5 meals	\$205

If you choose lodging somewhere other than Ross Point, the daily use fee and meal costs are as follows:

Thursday use fee (no meal)	\$10
lunches & use fees for Friday and Saturday	\$45
Friday dinner	\$15
Saturday dinner	\$15

Note: the workshop is Bloomsday weekend and hotel/motel rooms will be scarce.

Workshop registration (classes) fees are	\$80 both days
	\$45 one day (Friday or Saturday)

Every person coming to Ross Point (tatter, spouse, guest, visitor, or vendor) is required to submit a workshop registration form.
