COVID POLICY FOR SHUTTLEBIRDS TATTING GUILD 2022 WORKSHOP

In consideration of the services of **Shuttlebirds Tatting Guild**., their agents, owners, officers, volunteers, participants, employees, and all other persons or entities acting in any capacity on their behalf, I hereby agree to release, indemnify, and hold harmless Shuttlebirds Tatting Guild, on behalf of myself, my spouse, my children, my parents, my heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate as follows:

- 1. I acknowledge that my participation in any event conducted by **Shuttlebirds Tatting Guild** such as a camp, conference or retreat event entails known and unanticipated risks which could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis, death, or damage to myself, to property, or to third parties.
